RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN REBERVATION

WHEREAS. The Tribel business at this time does not justify the expense of manualining a capable Treasurer at the agency to receipt for and cay out Tribal Pands belonging to and paid out by the authority of the tribe, in order to facilitate the collecting, safekseping and disharasment of funds coming within the centrol of the Council,

RESOLVED BY the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent of the Forth Apache Indian Reservation be and he is hereby authorited to act as the receiving and disbursing agent of the White Research Apache Prabe. The Superintendent shall issue a receipt on his official receipt form indicating thereon that the collection is made in behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and shall deposit such funds in an Individual Indian Moneya account to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe. Disbursements of these funds shall be made by the Superintendent of his bended deputy upon the ap reval of this Resolution by and during the term of the present Council. The records of this Account shall be meas hours and it shall be the duty of the Treasurer to render a statement to the Council at least once a year or when called for.

The foregoing resolution was this 12th day of June 1944 duly adopted by a rous of 8 for and C against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain apache fribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (n), Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, on August 15, to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
