RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
WHITE APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of August, 1944, that

WHEREAS It is with the approval of the Tribal Council to submit to the Department of the Interior, recommendations for the expenditure of tribal funds for tribal support and reservation improvements and general welfare of the tribe and its individual members, and


WHEREAS There has been prepared an additional budget of proposed expenditures for the fiscal year 1945 not heretofore submitted but which expenditures seem necessary and advisable in the interest of tribal welfare, and according to properly manage the community building and support the best interest of the community and tribal business purposes for the present fiscal year that the following budget of expenditures be recommended for the approval of the Secretary from the Indian Indian Money, White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, as follows:


1. Salary of janitor for the care of the building.	\$900.00
2. Librarian in charge of community library.	350.00
3. Interpreter for the Council at \$5.00 per day.	70.00
4. Two associate judges at \$5.00 per day when called.	200.00
5. Fuel and light and other incidentals.	150.00
6. Daily papers and appropriate monthly magazines.	50.00
TOTAL.	\$1720.00


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve the above expenditure for the benefit of the community and the Apache Tribe of Indians for the Fiscal Year 1945.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1944 duly adopted by a vote of _____ yeas and _____ nays, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 14, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 14 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
