

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE Fort Apache Indian Reservation

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of May, 1946, that:

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the approved Tribal Constitution provides that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe shall have power:

"To deposit all funds of the tribe in an Individual Indian Account of the Fort Apache Indian Agency and to expend such funds in accordance with a budget approved by the Secretary of the Interior, but expenditures up to a total sum of \$1,000 in any one year may be made by the Council without such approval, "and

WHEREAS, an advanced estimate of proposed expenditures for the Tribal Old Folks Herd for the fiscal year, 1947, has been prepared after careful consideration of past necessary expenses and needs for the coming year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve the following budget for the operation of the Old Folks Herd for the fiscal year 1947.

Labor - - - - -	\$10,300.00
Groceries - - - - -	400.00
Feed and salt - - - - -	9,000.00
Fence repair - - - - -	2,000.00
Material for a bunk house, rope, paint, hardware and former Gross F headquarters cabin -	-1,000.00
Fuel and oil - - - - -	50.00
Automobile and trucking expense - - - - -	900.00
Veterinary and Artificial insemination materials and supplies	500.00
Three pack mules - - - - -	300.00
Juniper tree control - - - - -	-2,500.00
TOTAL - - - - -	<u>\$25,950.00</u>

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on May 6th 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
