

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that to encourage development of the reservation and communities adjacent thereto and,

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Electric Cooperative, Inc., has requested authority to make a survey for a proposed electric power line from McNary, Arizona (within the Fort Apache reservation) to the intersection of State Highway 77 and the north boundary of the reservation, a distance of approximately four and one-half miles, how

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that approval for such survey is hereby granted, it being expressly understood that such survey shall not locate the proposed line in any place that will interfere with the working of livestock or other essential activities of the reservation.

Done in regular meeting of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the first day of July 1948, a quorum being present and adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against.
