

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that the Navopache Electric Cooperative is hereby authorized to make the necessary surveys for the proposed electric transmission line from McNary, Arizona to various communities on the Fort Apache Reservation, including but not limited to, the North Fork Community, Whiteriver, East Fork Community, Fort Apache, Canyon Day Community, Kinishba Ruins and Museum and the William Creek Fish Hatchery.

This authorization is granted subject to approval by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs or his authorized representative in accordance with existing regulations.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on December 2, 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
