

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of May, 1946, that;

WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to construct a bunk house at the I.D. Ranch headquarters for use of the employees of the I.D. Herd, since there are now no facilities available for these employees.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR be requested to approve the expenditure of not to exceed \$1,000 for the construction of a bunk house at the I.D. Ranch Headquarters, said expenditures to be made from I.I.M. Account, I.D. Herd on deposit at the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on May 6th, 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 224).
