## RESOLUTION-OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe feels that in order to facilitate the work of the livestock industry on the reservation that additional transportation equipment is mesossary, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tribal funds in the amount of approximately \$2800, now on deposit to the credit of the tribe in Individual Indian Money accounts of the Port Apache Agency, be used to purchase a 2-ton truck equipped with stock rack to be used for livestock work and related hauling jobs.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on December 2, 1946, by a vote of \_\_\_\_\_for and \_\_\_against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
