## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE PORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in order to provide necessary funds for relief to the old and indigent members of the tribe there is hereby appropriated the sum of Six Thousand dollars (\$6000) from Tribal Funds on deposit in an I.I.M. account at Fort Apache Agency for Relief purposes during the remainder of fiscal year 1947.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on January 6, 1947, by unanimous vote by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
