RESCLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 152, authorizing the use of certain tribal funds for credit purposes has been approved and

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 182, covering a Plan of Operation for the lending program has been adopted by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that adequate clerical personnel for the program is essential, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the former clerical position for the Tribal Buying and Selling Interprise shall hereafter be the Tribal Credit Clerk and the incumbent shall handle all clerical work in connection with credit and loan activities of the Tribe and other accounting work of Tribal enterprises and associations. He will be responsible to the Superintendent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Credit Clerk position is hereby established on the same salary basis as a CAF-4 position under Government Service and shall have the same leave privileges and pay increases that are granted Government employees in like positions.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on January 6, 1947, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
