RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation in regular session this 8th day of July, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 184 adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe January 6, 1947, provides for the establishment of a Tribal Credit Clerk's position and,

WHEREAS, the Council desires that this position be filled by a competent person as soon as possible,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Council be hereby authorized to execute a contract for the employment of a clerk in the position authorized by Tribal Resolution No. 184, said contract to be signed by the Chairman of the Council and Chairman of the Tribal Council Credit Committee; provided that said contract shall be subject to the approval of the Superintendent or other officer in charge of the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on July 8, 1947, by a vote of for and against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 13, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
