

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN A Apache TRIBE OF THE
FORT A Apache INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in regular meeting assembled this 7th day of June, 1948, a quorum being present, that in order to provide funds for the continuation of certain tribal activities, for education, welfare and recreational purposes of the Indians, and for the development, protection and conservation of reservation resources, and for other purposes, during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1948 and ending June 30, 1949, there is hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in an Individual Indian Money account of the Fort Apache Indian Agency the following amounts for the purposes set forth:

(b) For camp ground improvements at Tonto

The foregoing proposed expenditures represent amounts estimated for tribal activities for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1948 and includes all contemplated activities and those which have been previously authorized by numerous separate resolutions. Supplemental budgets may be submitted for such items as may come up at a later date and which are not contemplated at this time or for which plans and estimates are not complete.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1948, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1939, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1939, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 304).
