RESOLUTION of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE of the FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe in regular session this 12th day of July, 1948,
that,

In order to assist members of the tribe who have joined the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. in getting their
homes wired for electricity that there is hereby
authorised the use of \$3,500 of tribal funds on
deposit with the Fort Apache Agency for advances to
individuals who need financial assistance in getting
their homes equipped for electricity.

PROVIDED THAT, each person using these funds for wiring of their homes will sign a repayment agreement providing for the repayment of said advances of funds,

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that such advances may be made to worthy applicants regardless of other loan contracts, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, that said loans for wiring purposes shall not be considered as being made under the revolving credit regulations.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on July 12, 1948, by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
