## RESOLUTION of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE of the FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe in regular session this 12th day of July, 1948,
that,

In order to continue the Revolving Credit Program which was initialed by Tribal Resolution Number 158, adopted July 1, 1946 that there is hereby authorized the additional sum of \$20,000 of tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency to the Revolving Credit Loan Fund authorized by Tribal Resolution Number 158.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$20,000 hereby provided will be used under the same credit regulations and under the same credit program as was authorized by Tribal Resolution Number 158.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1948, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority wested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
