

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

DO IT BEING, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the amount of \$3500 of the Tribal Funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency is hereby authorized to be used for expenses in connection with suppression of Forest Fires which have occurred on the Fort Apache Reservation during the 1948 fire season, provided that no additional Tribal Funds shall be authorized for fire suppression purposes during the Fiscal Year 1949 unless no other funds for fire suppression are available.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
