## RESCUITION OF THE WHITE YOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESCLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,

WHEREAS, Ernest Palmer, a member of the tribe, has requested the use of the house at what is known as the "Cooley Ranch" which is the property of the tribe and since Ernest Palmer has used of a house near McEary where he is regularly employed, said Fruest Palmer is hereby granted the right to occupy and use the house, sheds, yard, garden and small pasture of the said "Cooley Ranch" for a period of five years from Cotober 1, 1948 at a monthly rental of \$15.00 per month beginning at date of occupancy,

PROVIDID, that Frnest Palmer will repair the house at his own expense, supplying material of not less than \$500 value,

FORTHER, that said rental of \$15.00 per month will be credited towards the cost of repair materials used in repairing the said house and grounds, with the expressed understanding that when the value of the materials used in repairs is all credited against the monthly rental that cash rent shell be said the shite mountain Apache Tribe for the belance of the period of possupancy. It is further agreed that at the expiration of the five-year period that a renewal of the right of Ernest Calmer to cocupy the "Cooley Eanch" may be extended upon mutual agreement of the Tribal Council and Ernest Calmer.

h lease agreement duly drawn and executed between Arnest Palmer and the Thise Bountain Apache Tribe under authority of this resolution shall be binding upon both parties and the chairman of the White Fountain Apache Tribal Council is hereby authorized to sign said lease agreement for the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on eptember 15, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the Shite Mountain Apache Triba pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Triba, ratified by the Triba on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
