

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the request of the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., Lakeside, Arizona to survey for a proposed electric transmission line from the town of Mary, Arizona in a northerly direction to the north boundary of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and from a point on the east boundary of the reservation in a southwest-erly direction to the town of Maverick is hereby approved, subject to the provisions of 25CFR, Part 256.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 28, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
