

RESOLUTION
of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation this 7th day of February, 1949, that, in order to provide adequate protection for employees of the tribe engaged in livestock work, construction work, and miscellaneous lines of employment that application for compensation insurance is hereby authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that premiums for the payment of compensation insurance is authorized to be paid from tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency from the funds authorized for the particular work involved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that future estimates for use of tribal funds on work projects shall include the estimated amount for payment of premiums for compensation insurance.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1935 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1948, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1933 (48 Stat. 964).
