

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that, the request of the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., Lakeside, Arizona, to proceed with construction of the electric distribution line from a point on the East boundary of the reservation near reservation ranch in a Southwesterly direction to the town of Maverick, which survey was authorized by Tribal Resolution 268 approved September 13, 1948, is hereby granted subject to the provisions of Title 25 CFR, Part 256.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the request of the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. to proceed with a survey and construction of an electric transmission line from the town of Mahary in a Northwesterly direction towards Showlow, Arizona which will traverse reservation lands for approximately three miles tentatively described as crossing Sections 24, 13, 14, and 11, of T8N, R28E, S. 4 & 5, N.M., is hereby authorized subject to the provisions of Title 25 CFR, Part 256.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that damages shall be paid in accordance with provisions with Title 25 CFR, Part 256.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
