

RESOLUTION  
of the  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE  
of the  
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation that, in order for members of the Tribe to realize the fullest possible benefit from tribal funds set aside for loans for members of the tribe that in exceptional cases where loans in amounts exceeding \$1,000.00 to one individual or in the case where additional loans might cause the borrower to be indebted to the tribe or the Government in excess of \$1,000.00 may be approved by the Council upon recommendation of the Loan Committee providing such loans are made in accordance with the revolving credit regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Council Resolution No. 158 adopted July 1, 1946 is hereby amended to provide for loans in excess of \$1,000.00 as outlined herein.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 954).
