

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation that Tribal Resolution No. 292 adopted May 6, 1949 be hereby amended to authorize the expenditure not to exceed \$2500 for the construction of an industrial fence around the tribal fair buildings located on the fair grounds at Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on October 3, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and by-laws of the Tribe ratified by the tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 19, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
