RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIES OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. of McHary, Arizona, as Purchaser, has a timber contract on the McHary Burn Unit which expires as of March 51, 1949, and

WHEREAS, logging operations on the MoMary Burn Unit will not have been scampleted as of March 31, 1949,

HOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of March, 1949 that the contract covering the MoHary Burn Unit be extended to March 31, 1950.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1949 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(0) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
