

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that Nelson Lups is hereby authorized to raze the old house at the Pettis Ranch on North Fork.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Nelson Lups be responsible to remove all building materials from the site and clean up the premises in the satisfactory manner within six months from the date of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on the 14th date of July, 1930 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1933 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1933 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 834).
