

TERRITORIAL INDIAN TRIBAL RELIEF FUNDS
AUTHORIZED BY TRIBAL RESOLUTION NO. 50-29

All grants of relief from tribal funds authorized by the Tribal Council shall be made in accordance with the following regulations to indigent members of the tribe:

SECTION 1. APPLICATIONS: Members of the tribe in need of assistance are authorized to make application to the Relief Committee of the Council. No grants shall be approved until proper application has been made.

SECTION 2. ALLOWANCES AND GRANTS: Approved applications shall be on the following basis for a family unit:

Single person, adult, per month	\$35.00
Couple, (man and wife) per month	50.00
each child in family-5 years and under per month	6.00
each child in family-6 to 12 years per month	7.00
each child in family-13 to 18 years per month	8.00

SECTION 3. LIMITATIONS: The limit of grant per family unit for a month shall be governed by the allowances in SECTION 2, PROVIDING: Girls who become 18 years of age who have no means of support may be granted the allowance for such period as she remains a member of her family unit. The allowance shall not be granted the family for boys 18 years of age unless the boy remains in school or is unable to support himself because of physical or mental disability. PROVIDING FURTHER: The children of families receiving grants who are of school age must remain in school unless excused by proper authority, and failure of a child to attend school regularly shall be sufficient cause for the allowance granted for that child to be discontinued. PROVIDING FURTHER: If a relief recipient shall be convicted of an offense in any court of proper jurisdiction, allowances granted for that individual shall be discontinued for such period as is included in the jail sentence, regardless of whether a fine is paid in lieu of serving the sentence and the person released.

SECTION 4. OTHER INCOME: A family unit receiving income from other sources will have the monthly grant reduced in proportion to one-twelfth of the other income, providing other income does not exceed the total monthly grant times twelve; PROVIDING that other income (such as cattle sale receipts) shall remain in the recipient's Individual Indian Money account and paid to him only on a monthly basis.
