


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that since the water supply for the Canyon Day Water System authorized by funds provided in Resolution No. 292, is not adequate, authorization for the drilling of additional wells from funds provided for the system is hereby granted, PROVIDED that in the event an adequate water supply is obtained and additional funds are required to complete the installation of the community water system, then the Council will provide the necessary funds from Tribal funds not otherwise obligated.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 16, 1950 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
