

SECTION 5. PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT: Members of a family receiving relief grants who are temporarily or part-time employed but receive wages less than monthly grants, may receive partial relief payments to bring the monthly income to an amount at least equal to the family allowance authorized in SECTION 2. PROVISION: A relief recipient has an opportunity for employment for which he is qualified and capable of performing, but refuses without good cause to accept such employment, the relief grant shall be discontinued for such period as the employment would have continued.

SECTION 6. DOCTOR'S CERTIFICATE: Heads of families making application for relief by reason of physical disability shall obtain a doctor's certificate showing he is physically unable to work, if requested by the Relief Committee. In the absence of a medical certificate when requested, showing physical disability the committee shall not approve such applications.

SECTION 7. ILLGITIMATE CHILDREN: A woman without other means of support may receive grants, in accordance with SECTION 2, for only one illegitimate child.

SECTION 8. BURIAL EXPENSES: Relief funds may be used for burial expenses of indigent members of the tribe not to exceed \$50.00.

SECTION 9. LOANS FROM RELIEF FUNDS: In emergency situations of a welfare or relief nature loans from relief funds may be made in amounts not exceeding \$100.00, to one family unit, such loans shall be repaid within one year and loan agreements made under this section shall provide a definite repayment schedule showing the date such loan shall be repaid. Loan agreements shall have the approval of the chairman or acting chairman of the Tribal Council and shall also be approved by the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS: All applications for relief grants shall be carefully and fully considered by the Relief Committee of the Tribal Council. If the facts shown and the known information justifies the granting of relief payments, the application may be approved. Approval shall be signified by signature on the application by at least one member of the Relief Committee or the Chairman of the Tribal Council. Approved applications shall be subject to review by the Superintendent and the Superintendent may disapprove any application by giving his reasons in writing to the Relief Committee. If the Committee disagree with the findings of the Superintendent, the Committee shall refer the application to the Tribal Council, who shall either approve or disapprove the application. The decision of the Council shall be final.
