

RESOLUTION  
of the  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE  
of the  
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation this 7th day of February, 1949 that, in order to improve the health of the members of the Tribe and in order to provide the best possible protection against tuberculosis, it is hereby recommended that a BCG Immunization Program be conducted on the Fort Apache Reservation if possible during the current school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all members of the Council shall endeavor to obtain the support of all of the people in carrying on the BCG Immunization Program on the reservation and that all reasonable steps be taken to advise the people on the reservation concerning the program and that all possible encouragement will be given to enable the program to be carried through in accordance with the recommendations of the Health Division of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The following resolution was on February 7, 1949, duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1935 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1935, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 954).
