

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the sum of \$1500.00 is authorized from funds on deposit to the credit of the tribe in the Individual Indian Money Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the purchase of a light weight four-door sedan for the use of the tribal Special Officer, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 1951 model Ford Sedan now used for this purpose be traded on the purchase of the new vehicle.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 6, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
