

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is uneconomical to make further expenditures for maintenance of the present Tribal Council Vehicle,

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000.00) is hereby authorized from tribal funds on deposit in the individual Money accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the purpose of buying a new council vehicle. The old vehicle is to be traded in for its maximum value.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 8, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
