

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this council to assist with the improvement of the program of preventative medical work, and

WHEREAS, there is need at Cibecue for more adequate clinic facilities, therefore


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the SDA Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for remodeling a tribally owned building in the Cibecue Community. Said work to be carried on under direction of the Agency staff.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
