

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to complete the Medal Henss Development,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of ten thousand seven dollars (\$10,007.00) be transferred from deposits with the Treasurer of the United States to the Tribal Disbursing Account to complete this project, which is to include garages and landscaping.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 9, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
