RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Assembly of God Mission has applied for a permit to use a tract of tribal land in the Canyon Day District for mission purposes, and,

WHEREAS, the people in the community have indicated their approval of the request,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent of the Agency is hereby authorised to issue a revocable permit authorising the mission to use an asea of tribal land 210 feet square in the Canyon Day District.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 2, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
