

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 PORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED that the fire killed timber and other timber in need of cutting in the Boyce Spring Burn Logging Unit be advertised for sale to the highest bidder and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council be authorized to sign for the tribe a contract according to regulations for such sale and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a sum of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) be made available from tribal funds for newspaper advertisement of this timber.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 11, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
