- WHEREAS, the Council desires to express the appreciation of the White Hountain Apache people for the fine services he has rendered them and also desires to indicate the affection and respect which he has inspired among them, therefore
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that we do hereby adopt and accept him to be an Honorary Member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- OF IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the privileges attached to his honorary membership be as follows: a lifetime permit to hunt and fish within the confines of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation with the same seasonal duration, as well as bag and catch limits, as are granted to regular tribal members.
- EE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the best wishes of the Council and Tribe to extended to Mr. Crow and his fine family for a happy and successful life at their new station and also to express the hope that they will find many occasions to return.
