

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. G. L. Neel, of Holbrook, Arizona has an approved mining lease on the Fort Apache Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Neel has requested a site for a mill to be located on tribal land other than that now under lease to him, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Neel's request be granted on an area of tribal land not to exceed twenty (20) acres. The Chairman of the Council is hereby authorized to execute a lease or the Superintendent of the Agency to issue a permit, either document to be in accordance with the Constitution of the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 4, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
