

RESOLUTION OF THE  
TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN INDIAN RESERVATION

- 1. The Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approved the Constitution and By-Laws for the Apache Dutcher Inter-Tribe Association No. 7-1, and
- 2. The Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with the specifications and bid for a new club house house, and
- 3. The Tribal Council recognizes the importance of this structure to the future development of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
- 4. It is the policy of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to execute a contract not to exceed \$10,000 for the construction of a club house for the Apache Dutcher Inter-Tribe.

The above resolution was on April 2, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7-0 in favor and against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) and (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe in August 1, 1933 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 22, 1933 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 1, 1906 (34 Stat. 224).
