

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware of the fact that more than two-thirds of the individual income of the White Mountain Apache people is from the livestock industry, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes its responsibility to maintain and improve the breeding and quality of livestock on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the present progress in range improvements makes it considerably imperative that our ranges be kept up to stocking capacity, and

WHEREAS, we can have the opportunity to restock our ranges with outstanding registered cattle at a reasonable price,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has determined that the sum of \$20,000 be appropriated from the General Fund of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the immediate purchase of breeding stock.

That the Tribal Council has on April 1, 1931, duly adopted by a vote of _____ for and _____ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1, Paragraph (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Council on August 10, 1930 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 20, 1930 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1906 (Stat. 921).
