

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, for the period ending March 31, 1959 the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company will obtain its timber from the following units:

East Fork Logging Unit	4,000,000 Board Feet
Big Canyon Logging Unit	2,000,000 Board Feet
Diamond Creek Spruce-Fir Logging Unit	2,000,000 Board Feet
Bear Canyon No. 10 Logging Unit	500,000 Board Feet

which sources are authorized by the Forest Management Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that bids be requested for the logging and milling of this timber to be submitted to the Board of Directors for award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to approve contracts for the sources required.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
