

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 58-1a passed by the Council on the 7th day of January, 1958 amending the Constitution and By-Laws was forwarded to the Secretary of the Interior for his approval, and


WHEREAS, on the 29th day of May, 1958 the Secretary of the Interior accepted the proposed amended Constitution and By-Laws subject, however, to certain changes being made in the revised draft by the said Secretary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it is expedient to accept the recommendations of the Secretary of the Interior, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has recommended that the date of June 27, 1958 between the hours of 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM be set as the date for the Tribe to vote on said amended Constitution and By-Laws.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by a vote of 7 for, 1 abstaining and 0 against that the revised draft of the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona be submitted for adoption to the qualified voters of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on the 27th day of June, 1958.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) and Article IX, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
