

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, trips away from home or station are required during the proper conduct of business of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by various Tribal Officials and Employees, and

WHEREAS, the general economic status of these Officials and Employees does not compare favorably with the national average, making it often impossible to make a trip with their own funds (with the expectation of being re-imbursed at a later date),

BE IT RESOLVED, that payment of a substantial part of the estimated per diem, wages, and mileage due to be incurred on a properly authorized trip, may be made in advance of such trip, the remaining balance payable after submission of complete trip report, properly certified.

The foregoing resolution was on December 10, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
