

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Coulter No. 1 Logging Unit contract, for timber valued at approximately \$11,000, E. W. Henning, purchaser, was approved December 19, 1960, and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 1961 the purchaser requested that this contract be assigned to Whiting Brothers, St. Johns, Arizona, who have a sawmill at Eager, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, timber contract assignments have been made on the Red Lake and Lost Tank Canyon Units in 1945 and 1951 respectively.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the purchaser be authorized to assign the above mentioned contract to Whiting Brothers provided that all terms of the contract remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on February 1, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Mr. E. W. Henning, Pinetop, Arizona, was the successful bidder for the timber sale designated as Coulter No. 1 Logging Unit which was approved December 19, 1960. On January 25, 1961 Mr. Henning requested that his contract be assigned to the Whiting Brothers of St. Johns, Arizona. Resolution No. 61-9 authorizes the assignment of the above-mentioned contract to Whiting Brothers proviso all terms of the contract remain in full force and effect.

Resolution No. 61-9 was adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on February 1, 1961 pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
