RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE NOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the education of the Unite Mountain Apache children is of the utmost importance to the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, it is the further desire of the Tribal Council to encourage Tribal members to attend the church of their choice on Sunday.
- BE IT RESOLVED that during the school year, dances will be held only on Friday or Saturday of each week.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no basketball games or other athletic events shall be held until after 12:00 p.m. on Sunday of each week.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before any dances are held, permission of the Tribal Chairman shall be first had.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Hountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

Resolution No. 61-92 resolves that during the school year tribal dances will be held only on Friday and Saturday of each week. It further resolves that no basketball games or any athletic events shall be held until after 12:00 Moon on Sunday of each week.

The resolution further resolves that before any dances are held a permit must be obtained from the Tribal Chairman. The Tribal Council by passing this resolution are attempting to control all night sings or dances in the districts that interfere with school attendance.

The resolution was enacted on September 6, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to review or approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
