RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, five (5) cottages were constructed in 1955 at the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery to provide housing for Apache tribal members employed at the hatchery, and
- WHEREAS, the responsibility for assigning the cottages was delegated to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, some difficulty has been encountered in the coordination of maintenance activities, establishment of rental fees and collections.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the full responsibility for assigning personnel to these quarters, establishing rental fees, collections and maintenance be delegated to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all rental fees collected for the five (5) cottages be deposited in Account "-90-C.

Resolution No. 61-104 was enacted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution of the Tribe. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to rescission by by the Secretary of the Interior.

The resolution assigns the responsibility for the maintenance, establishment of rental fees and collections, and assigning of personnel to five cottages located at the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery. It also resolves that all rental fees collected for the five cottages be deposited in Account W-90C, the account for the Recreation Enterprise.
