

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., with office and principal place of business at Holbrook, Arizona, has requested permission from the White Mountain Apache Tribe to survey a right of way for a radio microwave site in the Smith Park Area, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe would benefit by the survey and construction of such an installation,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission to survey a right of way for a radio microwave site in the Smith Park area is hereby granted to the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., without the necessity of payment of any damages therefor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the survey be made in a location approved by the Tribal Recreation Manager.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Council and/or the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency be authorized and directed to execute any documents necessary to effectuate said survey.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
