

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the following savings will be made in the
FY 1961-62 budget:

\$750.00 - - Public Relations Expense
\$1,500.00 - - Commercial Accounting System
\$1,789.67 - - Educational Grants
\$4,039.69

and,

WHEREAS, the Council desires to operate a Youth Camp Program again this summer,
and there is not now enough funds left in the Youth Camp Operating
Expense Account to finish the remainder of this Fiscal Year,

BE IT RESOLVED that the actual savings not to exceed the sum of \$4,039.69 be
transferred from the above listed accounts to the Youth Camp
Operating Expense Account for use before June 30, 1962.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for
and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
