WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Fred Danashley, the Tribal Athletic Director, has to travel to distant cities on athletic business.

IT IS RESOLVED that he be allowed Twelve (\$12.00) Dollars per diem when off the Reservation on athletic business.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
