FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cibecue Sanitation Project is need of prisoners furnish the ditching, and


WHEREAS, the Community Club will need food for these prisoners.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$600.00 is to be donated to the Cibecue Club for the purpose of purchasing food for prisoners constructing the water lines and other sanitation projects in the Cibecue area.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1962, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
