

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Becker Creek No. 1 Salvage Logging Unit approved October 20, 1961 for 2,000,000 board feet of dead timber was contracted by Doy Reidhead of Show Low, Arizona and was to be completed by December 31, 1962, and

WHEREAS, due to the poor prices for lumber sawed from dead timber the contractor was unable to continue his cutting during the fall of 1962 and has on November 21, 1962 requested a one year time extension for this contract which was recommended by the Agency Forester.

BE IT RESOLVED that the above-mentioned contractor be granted a time extension to December 31, 1963 for completion of the Becker Creek No. 1 Salvage Logging Unit.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1962 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
