

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the H. L. Barnett Company in their timber operations have discovered certain coal deposits located on the Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the said company desires a prospecting permit to further geologize the area.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is authorized to grant the H. L. Barnett Company a prospecting permit for a period of ninety (90) days to prospect for coal. The said area being described as Sections 7 & 8, Township 7N, Range 23E located in Navajo County, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the H. L. Barnett Company pay to the Tribe the sum of \$200.00 for said prospecting permit.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
