

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Act of August 16, 1956 (70 Stat. 1057) authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to convey to any Indian Tribe, upon their request, title to any Federally-owned building, improvement or facility located on Indian land that are no longer required by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, Building No. 520 known as the McNary Warehouse located on the Apache Railroad in McNary is no longer needed or used by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, said building is needed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe for storage by the Livestock Associations.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe request that said Building No. 520 be conveyed to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe accepts responsibility for adequate maintenance and proper utilization of said building and realizes that the Secretary of the Interior, should he determine that the property is not being adequately maintained or properly utilized by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, or that the property creates a health or safety hazard, may declare a forfeiture of the transfer of title in which conveyed, the property shall revert to the United States.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
