

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Construction and Maintenance Enterprise can now purchase a second hand crusher for the sum of \$4 500.00 and

WHEREAS, said crusher is in excellent condition and will crush four times the amount of material as the crusher now owned by the Construction and Maintenance Enterprise and

WHEREAS, the Construction and Maintenance Manager is of the opinion that he can sell the present crusher for the sum of \$4 000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Construction and Maintenance Manager is hereby authorized to purchase one used crusher from the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. for the sum of \$4 500.00 and said sum to be provided by a savings and profit realized from the construction program.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V. Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
